Two days before the race this year, I rode my bike to the park to see if the wind had caused any problems with the course. As I passed the final trail before the finish line, I saw a park truck and a huge tree across the trail. There was no getting through so I began thinking how I could make a quick course change as I did last year. I spoke to the rangers and they told me not to worry, it will be clear before the race. They were right. I was very thankful, because I did not realize how cold it would be in the park, and I didn't wish to stay any longer than necessary. Putting a new course together would have taken a very long time.



The next evening, the night before the race, I returned to the park to put up cones and mile markers. It again was very cold. When I got to the trail, there were new changes. The park had picked that week to plow the trail and lay rocks across the creek area for trail repair. However, they left a disaster on the trail. **Tom Davies** came by on his evening run and tested the rocks, telling me most people wouldn't have a problem. That wasn't very encouraging. I moved a few rocks, but didn't have time to open the trail.

The next day, I lamented to **Yoshi Uemura** about the problem and he, with help from **Jeff Haag**, cleared the trail. You were all saved.

It was cold Saturday, but everyone seemed to have a great time. The numbers in the 10K were up a bit, and the 5K was quite a bit smaller than last year, but we still had 149 finishers. **Congratulations** to all the finishers and **thank you** for the smiles and complements.

Over the 45 years of this race, five 15-19 year old runners have run 34:03 or faster, the last one being Greg Phillips, who ran 34:03 in 1997. The winner of the Patrick's Point 10K this year was 18-year-old **Kellen O'Neill**, who ran 34:20 with no competition. The course we are running now is not as fast as the course from that was run up until 2012, so I believe Kellen's time would easily have made the top five. It is the record for the new course.

Tami Beall broke Karen Kelley-Day's 1996 record by 17 seconds with a 40:35 10K time and **John Norberg** established a new record in a new division, forming a 90-94 age group. There are no records kept for the 5K, but there were many outstanding performances.

I'd like to thank the people who helped Saturday. President **Gary Timek** was there early with the new course maps made by **David Howell** and Gary did all of the 5K timing. With one clock not working, **Yoshi Uemura**, who had cleared the rocks off of the course, helped me time the 10K and he also took care of the finish line. **Barry Milender** helped all over, helping direct the runners and with the finish tags. His wife, **Myrna**, helped with the finish and handed out cookies and water. **Matt Kidwell**, **Marlene Allen**, **Tanya Trump** and **Wendy Pearcy** helped my wife, **Jan**, with the registration and finish line. You may have noticed the people on the course. **Tom Martin** was at the crossroads. **Ken Yanosko** helped you stay safe after leaving the Patrick's Point Campground, **Amanda Reynolds** watched traffic and took care of the turn out of the parking lot, **Harry Kavich** made sure you were safe of the trail and **Juan Reyes** was at the turn around. Of course, **Yoon** was there, taking pictures and making sure all the results were correct, then putting everything up on the SRRC website (www.6rrc.com).

The SRRC party in the afternoon was beautifully organized by many SRRC members led by **Sherry Myers**. Everyone seemed to have a great time. There were many awards given to very deserving people. Thank you for being so warm and courteous at the party. This is a terrific club and attending our events and showing your support keeps us inspired. Please come out and donate your time to some of our events and earn a red jacket or one of the other awards.

The Patrick's Point results are the current circuit results. There will be a circuit article after the Sequoia Park Run. I hope you will all attend the Sequoia Park Run on Saturday, February 11 in Eureka. The 2-mile begins at 9:30 AM and the 5.3 mile begins soon after. There was no time specified.
