

About the Event

The purpose of the "Run in the Redwoods" is to raise support for the Redwood Parks Association (RPA), a local nonprofit that supports interpretive activities and visitor centers in 8 locations throughout Redwood National and State Parks. All proceeds from the event will benefit the parks. A portion of the funds will be used to improve the Revelation Trail for the blind, located adjacent to the Prairie Creek Redwoods State Park Visitor Center.

Locations & Directions

The park is located 50 miles North of Eureka and 25 miles South of Crescent City.

Directions from Eureka (coming from the south):

Take highway 101 North; take Newton B. Drury Parkway (exit 273); drive North on the parkway for 2 miles to Park Headquarters.

Directions from Crescent City (coming from the North):

Take 101 south; Past the North entrance to Prairie Creek as the road will be closed for the run. Continue south on 101 7 miles; turn onto Newton B. Drury Parkway (exit 273). Drive North on Parkway 2 miles to park headquarters.

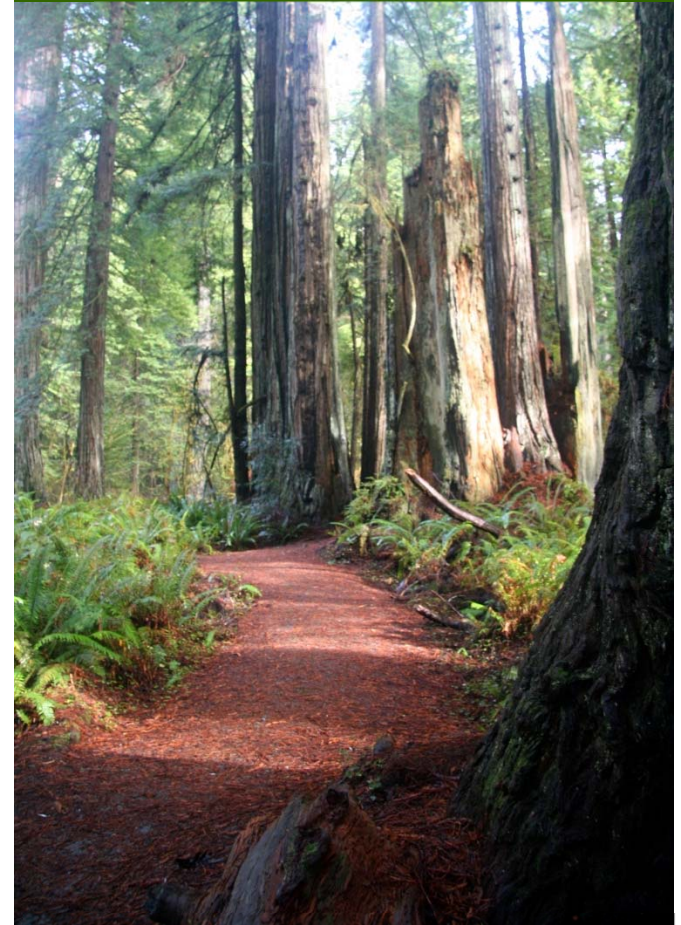

Information

When: Saturday September 13, 2014 at 9:00 am

Race Location: Prairie Creek Redwoods State Park Visitor Center, which is located 5 miles north of the town of Orick. Take Highway 101 to Newton B. Drury Scenic Parkway.

Course: The race will begin and end on the Newton B. Drury parkway at the intersection with the Visitor Center entrance road.

Half Marathon course will be on the Newton B. Drury Park way for 9 miles with the final 4 miles on the Prairie Creek Trail, ending back at the visitor center.

5k course will be on the Elk Prairie Trail and ending with the final stretch on the entrance road to Elk Prairie Campground.

Features: T-shirt, Refreshments, Timing, Aid stations stocked with water, healthy eats, and volunteers.

Awards Ceremony: The fastest three runners male and female finishers for each run will receive a trophy.

Entry Fee: Before August 30th, 2014, \$50.00 for Half Marathon and \$25.00 for 5K.

Restrictions: Limited to the first 200 registration forms received for each race. There are no dogs allowed on trails.
